Some Common PROBLEM LANGUAGE ERRORS for a person from NEPAL(Nepali) will be indicated for you by WORDS IN PURPLE .

Be sure that all FINAL POSITION Consonant sounds are put on the ends of words. In particiular, the "I" sound needs to be prolonged, slightly, to be correct.

"Thank" should not be mispronounced as "tank" and "there" should not be mispronounced as "dare."

Be sure to learn American English DIPTHONGS as in the words "game, tree, time, toe, flute, out or toy." Do NOT mispronounce American English "pure vowels" for the dipthongs.

Review plural words which stay the same for "one" or "more than one," such as "fish." There is no proper English word of "fishes."
